This video video discusses research conducted on men involved in two contrasting movements: the men's rights movement and feminist activism. The speaker initially sought to understand the motivations behind men's rights activism, which claims that men are discriminated against and contend that feminism has created a gender hierarchy favoring women. In contrast, feminist men recognize their privilege and aim to challenge it and work towards gender equality.

The research involved 62 semi-structured interviews with men from both movements, exploring their experiences, perceptions of gender inequality, and reasons for their activism. The study revealed both groups had similar emotional responses to confronting the idea of male privilege, with men's rights activists often feeling discomfort and anger, leading them to identify as victims rather than privileged. Conversely, feminist men grappled with their privilege but used this understanding to position themselves as moral allies to women.

This video video concludes with recommendations for fostering a more inclusive future, highlighting the importance of gender studies courses, providing low-stakes activism opportunities, promoting egalitarian cross-gender relationships, and protecting survivors of gender-based violence to encourage transformative understanding of gender issues. The overarching message emphasizes the relevance and impact of feminism in influencing men's awareness of their identities and social positions.
