5. **Challenges in Legislative Intention**: The speaker addresses the difficulty in discerning legislative intent due to varied understandings among parliament members. Courts often focus on the literal meaning of legislative wording rather than trying to decode the collective intention of the legislature.
6. **Practical Examples**: The discussion includes concrete legal cases that illustrate the application of the Principle of Legality, such as drug possession laws and migration regulations. These examples illustrate how courts navigate statutory language to protect individual rights while working within constitutional limits.
7. **Debate on Clarity and Authority**: The speaker highlights ongoing debates about how the principle creates uncertainty in interpretation while also encouraging clearer legislative drafting, ultimately aiming to protect individual rights without overstepping constitutional boundaries.

This video argues for the importance of understanding statutory interpretation not only as a legal technicality but as a fundamental aspect of ensuring justice and protecting rights within a legislative framework.
